

Ripley County Commissioners Meeting

September 24, 2018

The Commissioners' meeting opened promptly at 7:00 a.m. Monday, September 24, 2018 at the Ripley County Highway Garage, Osgood, Indiana. All Commissioners were in attendance as well as Auditor Wagner.

The commissioners discussed a complaint about excessive speed received from a landowner on Delaware Road.

Foreman Pat Kissell advised the new trucks were in route to Indianapolis to have the beds built.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Stratton moved to recess to the annex with a second from Commissioner Linville. Motion passed with 3 yes.

Commissioner Linville moved to reconvene the meeting with a second from Commissioner Stratton. Motion passed with 3 yes and Commissioner Stutler opened the meeting with the Pledge to the Flag. Commissioners Stutler, Linville, Stratton, Auditor Wagner, and County Attorney Ertel were in attendance.

Auditor Wagner brought up the issue with the gold paint on the clock tower on the Courthouse. The commissioners advised they wanted the Traditions Group to inspect the tower BEFORE any work was done to get a complete quote.

Sheriff—Jeff Cumberworth

Sheriff Cumberworth advised Mr. Jason Bolt was hired for the open position in the jail.

EMS—Mr. Scott Huffman

Mr. Huffman advised he was interviewing for the open position as Assistant Director for EMS.

EMA—Mr. Patrick Rose

Mr. Rose presented the commissioners with Memorandum of Understanding for Sunman Fire and Community Mental Health Center to be signed.

Southeastern Indiana Regional Planning Commission (SIRPC)—Ms. Mary McCarty
Ms. McCarty appeared for the Children’s Advocacy Center located in Dillsboro, Indiana. They were fulfilling the Public Hearing portion of the requirements of the grant. They have applied for a grant to open a new location in Decatur County to better serve Ripley County and Decatur County.
