# **Probation—Mr. Shannon Schmaltz**

Mr. Schmaltz advised he had not provided enough funding in the 2016 budget for the RCATS program for students that had been expelled from school. He was advised it could not be changed at this time and he would need to request an additional in 2016 for the additional \$3000.00 funds needed.

NOTES: Council Member Armbrecht moved to approve this request with a second from Council Member Pindell. Motion passed with 7 yes.

#### Prosecutor—Mr. Ric Hertel

Mr. Hertel advised he had received additional funding for the Victim Assistance Grant for the State fiscal year starting October 2015. The County match increased and funding was provided in the 2016 budget.

He also advised the Council that the Indiana Department of Criminal Justice had advised him that he would be in violation of the grant if he reduced the salary of the Victim Assistance Co-Ordinator and it would have to be established at the prior rate.

### City of Batesville—Merkel Road Project

Mayor Gene Lambert, Clerk Treasurer Ron Weigel, Batesville Board of Works Bill Flannery and Community/Economic Director Sarah Lamping presented the Council with an update of the Merkel Road Project and the economic development in the Business Parks in Batesville. They provided numbers of employees and the future expansion for the parks that will put additional traffic on Merkel Road and the need for the update to that road. The original cost to update the road has changed from the original estimate the commissioners were presented around 18 months ago when \$100,000.00 was committed. These funds were never requested and Batesville is requesting 50% funding from the County for the improvements to Merkel Road which is approximately \$500,000.00.

Council President Dephane Smith appointed Council Members Horstman, Wetzler, Armbrecht and the Commissioners appointed Commissioner Linville to a committee to work with Batesville on this project.

#### OTHER INFORMATION:

Council Member Armbrecht questioned whether the Coroner had provided job descriptions for the volunteer coroner's assistants. Auditor Wagner advised he had not received them. Council Member Armbrecht then moved to rescind the previous action allowing the Coroner 3 unpaid volunteer assistant positions for the 2016 budget period. If received consideration would be made at that time. Council Member Decker seconded and the motion passed with 7 yes.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT: none**

Council Member Armbrecht moved to recess the regular meeting and open the Budget Adoption Meeting for the County and Solid Waste. Council Member Horstman seconded and the motion passed with 7 yes.

The Council revisited the Community Corrections budget and made a transfer from line item keyless entry (41550) to Equipment (49000). Council Member Pindell moved to approve this with a second from Council Member Wetzler. Motion passed with 7 yes. This did not change the total budget request for 2016.

The Council revisited the Victim Assistance Grand budget and changed the Victim Assistance Coordinator to \$46,423.00 (12800). Also, postage (25600) and travel expense (34800) was reduced to zero. Council Member Wetzler moved to approve these changes with a second from Council Member Decker. Motion passed with 7 yes.

Next the Council revisited the Commissioners budget due to the increased amount of matching funds needed for the Victim Assistance Grant. Item (32327) Matching Victim Assistance was increased to \$20915.00. Council Member Wetzler moved to approve this change with a second from Council Member Horstman. Motion passed with 7 yes.

Council Member Warren then moved to approve the 2016 budget for Ripley County and Solid Waste as presented after the changes. Council member Pindell seconded and the motion passed with 7 yes.

Council Member Armbrecht moved to reconvene the regular meeting with a second from Council Member Wetzler. Motion passed with 7 yes and the meeting was reconvened.

Auditor Wagner advised the Council the December meeting would need to be changed to allow DLGF time to consider any additional appropriations needed in 2015. Council agreed to a December 14, 2015 date and this change will be advertised for the public notification.
