October 21, 2019

The Ripley County Council met on Monday, October 21, 2019 at the Ripley County Annex in Versailles, Indiana. Council President Brenda Wetzler opened the 2020 Budget Adoption Meeting for Ripley County and Southeastern Indiana Solid Waste Management with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.
