

## News release Motorcycle Accident

On Thursday August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at about 6:44 pm. Ripley County Communications received a report of a Motorcycle accident with injuries located on US 421 just north of Michigan road in Napoleon.

When Ripley County Deputy Steve Sullivan arrived at the scene, he found 27 year old Chasity Faye Winters lying on the ground off the east side of the roadway. A Napoleon Fireman/ First responder had arrived and was already treating Chasity.


Chasity sustained head injuries and several scrapes from falling off the back of a 2003 Yamaha Motorcycle operated by 33-year-old Robert J. Hornsby.

Hornsby told Officers that he shifted into second gear and Chasity lost her balance and fell off the Motorcycle.

Chasity was transported to Margaret Mary hospital in Batesville to be treated for her injuries and may have to be transported to Cincinnati by Air-care.

Neither Chasity nor Robert was wearing helmets. Officers believe speed may have played a factor in the accident also.

Deputy Steve Sullivan is investigating the accident. Deputy Andy Hammack, Rescue-69, Ripley County Medic, and Napoleon fire/ First responders assisted him at the scene.
