

Ripley County Sheriff's report for October 2015 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for October 2015.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 43 criminal cases during October.

- Alcohol related offenses-9
- Drug related offenses-7
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile related Offenses-3
- Domestic related offenses- 14
- Property related offenses- 19
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 2

Out of the 55 criminal cases received, 20 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 23 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for October was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 39 motor vehicle accidents. There were 32 property damage accidents, 7 personal injury accidents with 9 persons being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was an animal in the roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 29 warrants and 177 civil process papers were served during October, 2015. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 19 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 77 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in October was \$8,820.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 2,133 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 182.75 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in October. They worked 4 property damage accidents and 1 person injury accident. These volunteer officers also served 66 civil process papers, 3 warrants and worked 4 cases.
