

## **Ripley County Sheriff's report for January 2014 activity**

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for January 2014.

### **Criminal Cases:**

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 35 criminal cases during January.

- Alcohol related offenses-8
- Drug related offenses-2
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-3
- Juvenile Related Offenses-4
- Domestic related offenses- 5
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property-16

Out of the 35 criminal cases received, 23 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 12 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for January was Theft.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents:**

Deputies investigated a total of 34 motor vehicle accidents. There were 30 property damage accidents, 4 personal injury accidents with 4 people being injured and 0 fatalities. The most frequent cause of accidents was running off the roadway.

### **Civil Process Service:**

A total of 24 warrants and 264 civil process papers were served during January 2014. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 12 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

**Ripley County Jail:**

There were 69 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being alcohol related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in January was \$5,355.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 3,043 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

**Reserve Officers:**

Ripley County Reserve Officers worked 165.5 hours in January and served 23 civil process notices.
