

## **Ripley County Sheriff's report for January 2015 activity**

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for January 2015.

### **Criminal Cases:**

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 41 criminal cases during January.

- Alcohol related offenses-5
- Drug related offenses-3
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-3
- Juvenile related Offenses-0
- Domestic related offenses- 14
- Property related offenses- 25
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 7

Out of the 41 criminal cases received, 22 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 19 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for January was Theft.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents:**

Deputies investigated a total of 31 motor vehicle accidents. There were 27 property damage accidents, 4 personal injury accidents with 6 persons being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was animal in the roadway.

### **Civil Process Service:**

A total of 15 warrants and 187 civil process papers were served during January 2015. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 20 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

**Ripley County Jail:**

There were 63 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in January was \$15,610.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 1,047 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

**Reserve Deputies:**

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 286.5 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in January. They worked one personal injury accident and three property damage accidents. These volunteer officers also served 64 civil process papers, 3 warrants and worked five cases.
