

Ripley County Sheriff's report for February 2013 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office, gives a summary of activity for February 2013.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 44 criminal cases during February.

- Alcohol related offenses-17
- Drug related offenses-8
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses- 4
- Juvenile Related Offenses- 0
- Domestic related offenses- 7
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property-24

Out of the 44 criminal cases received, 29 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 15 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for February was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 24 motor vehicle accidents. There were 23 property damage accidents, 1 personal injury accident with 1 person being injured and 0 fatalities. The most frequent cause of accidents was animal in the roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 32 warrants and 190 civil process papers were served during February 2013. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 62 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 66 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in February was \$17,220.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 6,976 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.
