

## **Ripley County Sheriff's report for February 2015 activity**

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for February 2015.

### **Criminal Cases:**

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 35 criminal cases during February.

- Alcohol related offenses-6
- Drug related offenses-3
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile related Offenses-2
- Domestic related offenses- 11
- Property related offenses- 15
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 3

Out of the 35 criminal cases received, 23 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 12 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for February was Theft.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents:**

Deputies investigated a total of 32 motor vehicle accidents. There were 24 property damage accidents, 8 personal injury accidents with 9 persons being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was the driver running off of the road.

### **Civil Process Service:**

A total of 23 warrants and 144 civil process papers were served during February 2015. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 9 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

**Ripley County Jail:**

There were 60 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being alcohol related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in February was \$16,135.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 1,932 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

**Reserve Deputies:**

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 165 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in February. They worked one personal injury accident and three property damage accidents. These volunteer officers also served 55 civil process papers, 2 warrants and worked 4 cases.
