

## **Ripley County Sheriff's report for March 2015 activity**

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for March 2015.

### **Criminal Cases:**

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 35 criminal cases during February.

- Alcohol related offenses-3
- Drug related offenses-3
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile related Offenses-4
- Domestic related offenses- 11
- Property related offenses- 12
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 2

Out of the 35 criminal cases received, 24 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 11 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for March was Theft and Battery.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents:**

Deputies investigated a total of 27 motor vehicle accidents. There were 21 property damage accidents, 6 personal injury accidents with 7 persons being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was an animal in the roadway.

### **Civil Process Service:**

A total of 29 warrants and 218 civil process papers were served during March 2015. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 26 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

**Ripley County Jail:**

There were 77 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug and paraphernalia related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in March was \$8,750.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 1785 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

**Reserve Deputies:**

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 201 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in March. They worked three property damage accidents. These volunteer officers also served 38 civil process papers, 5 warrants and worked 4 cases.
