

## **Ripley County Sheriff's report for March 2016 activity**

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for March 2016.

### **Criminal Cases:**

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 52 criminal cases during March.

- Alcohol related offenses-8
- Drug related offenses-4
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-5
- Juvenile related Offenses-15
- Domestic related offenses- 17
- Property related offenses- 27
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 7

Out of the 52 criminal cases received, 35 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 17 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for March was Battery.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents:**

Deputies investigated a total of 21 motor vehicle accidents. There were 20 property damage accidents, 1 personal injury accident with 1 person being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was an animal in the roadway.

### **Civil Process Service:**

A total of 27 warrants and 200 civil process papers were served during March, 2016. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 48 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

**Ripley County Jail:**

There were 86 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being alcohol related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in March was \$13,860.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 3,132 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments, prison and extraditions.

**Reserve Deputies:**

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 147 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in March. These volunteer officers also served 20 civil process papers.
