

Ripley County Sheriff's report for April 2013 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office, gives a summary of activity for April 2013.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 56 criminal cases during April.

- Alcohol related offenses-7
- Drug related offenses-5
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-1
- Juvenile Related Offenses-0
- Domestic related offenses- 11
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property-46

Out of the 56 criminal cases received, 28 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 28 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for April was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 34 motor vehicle accidents. There were 29 property damage accidents, 5 personal injury accidents with 7 people being injured and 0 fatalities. The most frequent cause of accidents was animal/object in roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 26 warrants and 217 civil process papers were served during April 2013. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 27 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 78 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in April was \$27,090.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 3,670 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Officers:

Ripley County Reserve Officers worked 109.5 hours in April and served 41 civil process notices.
