

Ripley County Sheriff's report for March 2015 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for April 2015.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 44 criminal cases during April.

- Alcohol related offenses-9
- Drug related offenses-1
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile related Offenses-4
- Domestic related offenses- 14
- Property related offenses- 18
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 3

Out of the 44 criminal cases received, 29 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 15 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for April was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 40 motor vehicle accidents. There were 35 property damage accidents, 5 personal injury accidents with 8 persons being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was running off of the road to the right.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 25 warrants and 233 civil process papers were served during April 2015. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 26 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 86 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug and paraphernalia related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in April was \$21,245.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 2,635 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 227.75 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in April. They worked 4 property damage accidents. These volunteer officers also served 60 civil process papers, 4 warrants and worked 7 cases.
