

Ripley County Sheriff's report for May 2015 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for May 2015.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 34 criminal cases during May.

- Alcohol related offenses-2
- Drug related offenses-2
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-3
- Juvenile related Offenses-0
- Domestic related offenses- 12
- Property related offenses- 18
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 4

Out of the 34 criminal cases received, 21 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 13 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for May was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 32 motor vehicle accidents. There were 26 property damage accidents, 6 personal injury accidents with 7 persons being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was running off of the road to the right.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 21 warrants and 262 civil process papers were served during May 2015. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 7 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 76 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being alcohol related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in May was \$8,435.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 2,518 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 155 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in May. They worked 3 property damage accidents. These volunteer officers also served 60 civil process papers, 4 warrants and worked 3 cases.
