

Ripley County Sheriff's report for May 2016 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for May 2016.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 59 criminal cases during June.

- Alcohol related offenses-3
- Drug related offenses-5
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-10
- Juvenile related Offenses-0
- Domestic related offenses- 17
- Property related offenses- 24
- Animal related offenses - 1
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 10

Out of the 59 criminal cases received, 40 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 19 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for May was Battery/ Domestic Battery.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 39 motor vehicle accidents. There were 35 property damage accidents, 4 personal injury accidents with 6 people being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was an animal or object in the roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 36 warrants and 206 civil process papers were served during May, 2016. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 20 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 76 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in May was \$15,295.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 3,760 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments, prison and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 148.75 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in May. These volunteer officers also served 35 civil process papers and 1 warrant and worked 7 property damage accidents.
