

Ripley County Sheriff's report for June 2016 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for June 2016.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 41 criminal cases during June.

- Alcohol related offenses-4
- Drug related offenses-4
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-6
- Juvenile related Offenses-0
- Domestic related offenses- 6
- Property related offenses- 23
- Animal related offenses - 0
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 6

Out of the 41 criminal cases received, 25 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 16 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for June was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 30 motor vehicle accidents. There were 22 property damage accidents, 8 personal injury accidents with 10 people being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was an animal or object in the roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 47 warrants and 235 civil process papers were served during June, 2016. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 16 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 77 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in June was \$14,735.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 3,111 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments, prison and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 101 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in June. These volunteer officers also served 39 civil process papers and 4 warrants and worked 1 property damage accident.
