

Ripley County Sheriff's report for July 2013 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office, gives a summary of activity for July 2013.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 55 criminal cases during July.

- Alcohol related offenses-12
- Drug related offenses-3
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile Related Offenses-5
- Domestic related offenses- 16
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property-38

Out of the 55 criminal cases received, 30 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 25 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for July was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 22 motor vehicle accidents. There were 18 property damage accidents, 4 personal injury accidents with 12 people being injured and 0 fatalities. The most frequent cause of accidents was animal/object in roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 39 warrants and 216 civil process papers were served during July 2013. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 14 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 65 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in July was \$14,980.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 2,266 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Officers:

Ripley County Reserve Officers worked 163.5 hours in July and served 15 civil process notices.
