

Ripley County Sheriff's report for July 2014 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for July 2014.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 48 criminal cases during June.

- Alcohol related offenses-7
- Drug related offenses-5
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile Related Offenses-4
- Domestic related offenses- 8
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property-36

Out of the 48 criminal cases received, 33 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 15 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for July was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 39 motor vehicle accidents. There were 28 property damage accidents, 11 personal injury accidents with 12 persons being injured and 0 fatalities. The most frequent cause of accidents was running off the road.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 20 warrants and 142 civil process papers were served during July 2014. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 9 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 73 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being alcohol related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in July was \$6,965.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 4,499 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Officers:

Ripley County Reserve Officers worked 380 hours and served 111 civil process notices and 6 warrants in July.
