

Ripley County Sheriff's report for July 2016 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for July 2016.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 42 criminal cases during July.

- Alcohol related offenses-8
- Drug related offenses-3
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-3
- Juvenile related Offenses-1
- Domestic related offenses- 10
- Property related offenses- 15
- Animal related offenses - 0
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 2

Out of the 42 criminal cases received, 28 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 14 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for July was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 44 motor vehicle accidents. There were 30 property damage accidents, 14 personal injury accidents with 18 people being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was an animal or object in the roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 40 warrants and 198 civil process papers were served during July, 2016. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 21 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 74 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in July was \$20,755.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 2,568 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments, prison and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 153 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in July. These volunteer officers also served 18 civil process papers and 4 warrants and worked 2 property damage accidents.
