

Ripley County Sheriff's report for August 2013 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office, gives a summary of activity for August 2013.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 57 criminal cases during August.

- Alcohol related offenses-14
- Drug related offenses-9
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-3
- Juvenile Related Offenses-2
- Domestic related offenses- 13
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property-30

Out of the 57 criminal cases received, 37 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 20 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for August was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 39 motor vehicle accidents. There were 30 property damage accidents, 9 personal injury accidents with 11 people being injured and 0 fatalities. The most frequent cause of accidents was animal/object in roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 37 warrants and 264 civil process papers were served during August 2013. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 10 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 73 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being alcohol related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in August was \$12,250.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 2,688 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Officers:

Ripley County Reserve Officers worked 189 hours in August and served 17 civil process notices.
