

Ripley County Sheriff's report for August 2014 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for August 2014.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 44 criminal cases during August.

- Alcohol related offenses-8
- Drug related offenses-1
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-3
- Juvenile Related Offenses-0
- Domestic related offenses- 13
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property-25

Out of the 44 criminal cases received, 22 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 22 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for August was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 25 motor vehicle accidents. There were 16 property damage accidents, 9 personal injury accidents with 9 persons being injured and 0 fatalities. The most frequent cause of accidents was animal in the roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 31 warrants and 192 civil process papers were served during August 2014. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 6 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 80 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being alcohol related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in August was \$4,585.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 3,477 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Officers:

Ripley County Reserve Officers worked 372.5 hours and served 107 civil process notices and 6 warrants in August.
