

Ripley County Sheriff's report for August 2015 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for August 2015.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 45 criminal cases during August.

- Alcohol related offenses-9
- Drug related offenses-3
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile related Offenses-1
- Domestic related offenses- 13
- Property related offenses- 22
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 5

Out of the 45 criminal cases received, 28 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 17 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for August was Theft and Battery.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 30 motor vehicle accidents. There were 23 property damage accidents, 7 personal injury accidents with 10 persons being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was an animal in the roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 27 warrants and 133 civil process papers were served during August, 2015. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 17 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 93 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being alcohol related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in August was \$11,270.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 1,224 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 147.5 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in August. They worked 2 property damage accidents. These volunteer officers also served 43 civil process papers, 4 warrants and worked 4 cases.
