

## **Ripley County Sheriff's report for August 2016 activity**

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for August 2016.

### **Criminal Cases:**

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 52 criminal cases during August.

- Alcohol related offenses-10
- Drug related offenses-9
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile related Offenses-1
- Domestic related offenses- 15
- Property related offenses- 15
- Animal related offenses - 0
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 6

Out of the 52 criminal cases received, 29 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 13 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for August was Battery.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents:**

Deputies investigated a total of 44 motor vehicle accidents. There were 33 property damage accidents, 11 personal injury accidents with 13 people being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was running off of the road to the right.

### **Civil Process Service:**

A total of 36 warrants and 212 civil process papers were served during August, 2016. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 24 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

**Ripley County Jail:**

There were 80 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in July was \$20,335.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 3,212 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments, prison and extraditions.

**Reserve Deputies:**

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 73 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in August. These volunteer officers also served 24 civil process papers and 3 warrants and worked 1 property damage accident.
