

Ripley County Sheriff's report for September 2015 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for September 2015.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 55 criminal cases during September.

- Alcohol related offenses-41
- Drug related offenses-2
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-3
- Juvenile related Offenses-0
- Domestic related offenses- 10
- Property related offenses- 34
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 4

Out of the 55 criminal cases received, 26 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 29 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for September was Minor Consumption.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 41 motor vehicle accidents. There were 30 property damage accidents, 11 personal injury accidents with 27 persons being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was an animal in the roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 31 warrants and 199 civil process papers were served during September, 2015. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 24 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 77 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in September was \$12,600.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 1,926 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 139 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in September. They worked 2 property damage accidents and 3 person injury accidents. These volunteer officers also served 30 civil process papers and worked 6 cases.
