

Ripley County Sheriff's report for September 2016 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for September 2016.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 53 criminal cases during September.

- Alcohol related offenses-4
- Drug related offenses-7
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile related Offenses-1
- Domestic related offenses- 16
- Property related offenses- 12
- Animal related offenses - 0
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 6

Out of the 53 criminal cases received, 35 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 18 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for September was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 33 motor vehicle accidents. There were 28 property damage accidents, 5 personal injury accidents with 7 people being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was running off of the road to the right.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 34 warrants and 277 civil process papers were served during September, 2016. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 26 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 75 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in August was \$21,385.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 3,364 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments, prison and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 140 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in September. These volunteer officers also served 21 civil process papers and 4 warrants and worked 3 property damage accidents.
