

## **Ripley County Sheriff's report for October 2014 activity**

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for October 2014.

### **Criminal Cases:**

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 39 criminal cases during October.

- Alcohol related offenses-7
- Drug related offenses-3
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile Related Offenses-1
- Domestic related offenses- 9
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property-27

Out of the 39 criminal cases received, 21 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 18 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for October was Theft.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents:**

Deputies investigated a total of 42 motor vehicle accidents. There were 38 property damage accidents, 4 personal injury accidents with 5 persons being injured and 0 fatalities. The most frequent cause of accidents was animal in the roadway.

### **Civil Process Service:**

A total of 20 warrants and 181 civil process papers were served during October 2014. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 18 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

**Ripley County Jail:**

There were 65 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in October was \$12,700.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 2,107 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

**Reserve Officers:**

Ripley County Reserve Officers worked 213.5 hours and served 39 civil process notices and 5 warrants in October.
