

## **Ripley County Sheriff's report for November 2013 activity**

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office, gives a summary of activity for November 2013.

### **Criminal Cases:**

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 55 criminal cases during November.

- Alcohol related offenses-14
- Drug related offenses-5
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-4
- Juvenile Related Offenses-6
- Domestic related offenses- 12
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property-29

Out of the 55 criminal cases received, 33 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 22 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for November was Theft.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents:**

Deputies investigated a total of 49 motor vehicle accidents. There were 44 property damage accidents, 4 personal injury accidents with 8 people being injured and 1 fatalities. The most frequent cause of accidents was animal/object in roadway.

### **Civil Process Service:**

A total of 37 warrants and 150 civil process papers were served during November 2013. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 5 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

**Ripley County Jail:**

There were 81 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug or alcohol related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in November was \$11,340.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 5,333 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

**Reserve Officers:**

Ripley County Reserve Officers worked 217.5 hours in November and served 48 civil process notices.
