

Ripley County Sheriff's report for December 2015 activity

A report generated by the Ripley County Sheriff's Office gives a summary of activity for December 2015.

Criminal Cases:

The Ripley County Sheriff's Office received 57 criminal cases during December.

- Alcohol related offenses-8
- Drug related offenses-10
- Misdemeanor/Felony traffic offenses-2
- Juvenile related Offenses-6
- Domestic related offenses- 14
- Property related offenses- 25
- Misc. Crimes against persons/ property- 2

Out of the 57 criminal cases received, 34 were either closed or resulted in arrest and 23 cases remain open, under investigation. The most frequent charge for December was Theft.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Deputies investigated a total of 34 motor vehicle accidents. There were 25 property damage accidents, 9 personal injury accidents with 9 persons being injured. The most frequent cause of accidents was an animal in the roadway.

Civil Process Service:

A total of 28 warrants and 200 civil process papers were served during December, 2015. They include subpoenas, summons, notifications of Sheriff's Sales, eviction notices, small claim actions and complaints and tax warrants.

There were 93 firearm permits applied for or renewed through the Sheriff's office.

Ripley County Jail:

There were 82 prisoners booked into the facility with the most frequent charge being drug related. The total billed to other facilities for housing in December was \$13,755.00.

Ripley County Deputies and Jail Officers traveled a total of 2,210 miles transporting prisoners to court appointments, doctor's and dentist appointments and extraditions.

Reserve Deputies:

Reserve Deputies worked a total of 145 hours for the Ripley County Sheriff's Office in December. They worked 4 property damage accidents and 1 person injury accident. These volunteer officers also served 8 civil process papers, 2 warrants and worked 4 cases.
