On Friday night, March 5th, 2010, the Ripley County Sheriff's Office, working in cooperation with the Batesville Police Department and the Ripley County Prosecutors Office, executed a Search Warrant issued by the Ripley Superior Court, at a Batesville residence, resulting in several arrest and the seizure of a large quantity of Cocaine packaged for sale.

Maintaining a Common Nuisance, class D Felony.


